### NOTAS

“Labor” es trabajo en general y tareas del campo en particular; también es coser y bordar tejidos, y, en algunas lenguas, parir.

Esta “Labor” plantea un juego de reflexión sobre el trabajo de los músicos en la Andalucía de hoy y, por extensión, sobre el trabajo de todos aquellos que quieran darse por aludidos. Música entendida aquí como el *juego* (*play, joeux, spielen...*) en el que los músicos nos jugamos la vida. Y, puesto que, en un concierto, el público también juega, algo de su vida también pondrá en juego (?).

A nivel formal, esta composición escenifica un diálogo, en clave de humor, entre dos “hermanas” que nunca se han entendido: la Serie Armónica y la Serie Dodecafónica. Ambas conversan en el continuo que se extiende desde los ritmos a las frecuencias, de los acordes a los timbres, desde lo eterno al instante...
